INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE: Participants will survey the literature, history, and faith of the people of Israel as recorded in the Old Testament and the new Israel of God as described in the New Testament. They will examine key elements of the narrative and explore how the church of Jesus Christ has come to view its history and itself. This course will be led by Dr. Bob Bryant, Professor of Bible at Presbyterian College, and favorite School of the Laity faculty member of many years.

PRE-COURSE WORK: Participants are encouraged to purchase The New Oxford Annotated Bible with Apocrypha: New Revised Standard Version, 5th ed. In addition, Dr Bob has prepared an "Introduction to the Bible: A Reader's Guide" to guide you in reading through scripture. This guide will be sent to you upon registration- so register early!

INTRODUCTION TO REFORMED THEOLOGY: Provides a foundational introduction to Reformed Theology and explores how it shapes and informs the ministry of the Presbyterian Church (USA). Presbyterian view of scripture, Attributes of God, Major Doctrines of the Church, The Trinity, incarnation, salvation, justification, sanctification, and predestination. This course is led by Rev. Dr. Kirk Nolan, Professor of Religion & Philosophy at Presbyterian College where he teaches courses in theology, ethics, and biblical studies.



<u>PRE-COURSE WORK:</u> Participants are required to read *Christian Doctrine* (revised edition) by Shirley C. Guthrie Jr. <u>A reading guide, including questions, will be provided upon registration</u>.



PRACTICAL MINISTRIES: This course is the capstone of the School of the Laity program. Practical Ministry, as participants will study and practice in this course, aims to approach ministry from the viewpoint of God's provisioning us to engage in ministry, service, as led by the Spirit of the Lord. **Course will be led by Rev. Jamil el-Shair, Pastor of Altama Presbyterian.**

PRE-COURSE WORK: Read the following scripture passages: Exodus 12:33-39; 25 - 27; Luke 9:1-20 and the "Resources" section of *The Four Essential*

Elements of an Asset-based Community Development Process 2 by Cormac Russell (emailed with registration confirmation).
