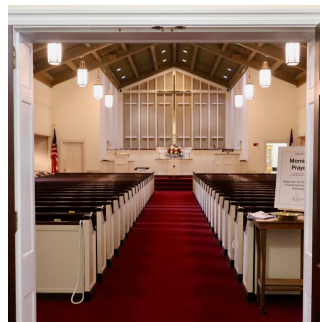

## ...Looking Back

Completed Since November 2019

- Demolition completed on transept and chancel walls.
- Footers dug and concrete poured for widened transepts and new gathering space.
- Asbestos abatement completed.
- New steel installed for both transepts.
- Roofing, liturgical furniture, audio/visual, and window details finalized.

## Looking Ahead...

Anticipated Progress in January/February 2020

- Construction of transept, gathering space, and west chancel walls continues.
- Roof installation on sanctuary, Ashantilly Wing, and additional renovated spaces.
- HVAC ductwork and new conduit installed.
- Complete structural stabilization of interior walls in nave.

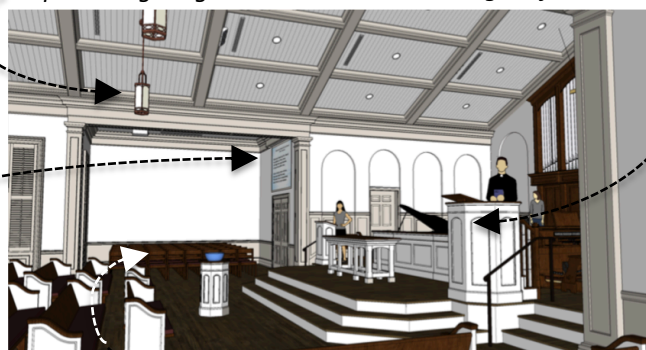

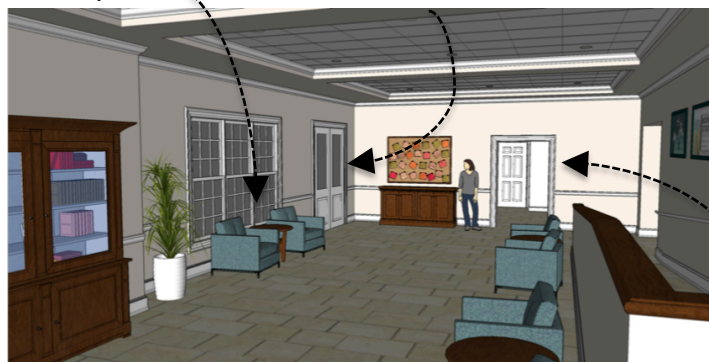
