

#### HIGHLIGHTS IN THE HISTORY OF THE CHURCH

The St. Simons Presbyterian Church was organized by a commission of Savannah Presbytery on September 29, 1946 with 46 Charter members. Worship began at the County Casino with the use of temporary supplies.

On January 1, 1947 Dr. James Thornwell Gillespie, with Mrs. Gillespie, came to become the Church's first pastor.

On July 1, 1947 the congregation, through the generous kindness of Mrs. B. F. Mann and her family, moved to the Community Church, the property of the Mann Estate, and began its worship there.

The Church began as a home mission church, with aid from the Presbytery. But after three and one-half years it became self-supporting.

Since the day of its organization 266 new members have been added to the original 46 Charter members. The Sunday School has grown from 20 to 172 enrolled members.

By the summer of 1950 it began to be obvious that plans must be started looking toward the construction of a church plant. To this end the congregation, on August 20 of that summer, elected a temporary Planning Committee

On March 1, 1951 a Building Fund campaign was launched at a dinner meeting with the view to securing the Means. Dr. J. R. McCain of Agnes Scott College delivered the inspirational message.

The Plans, as presented by the Building Committee, were adopted by the congregation October 11, 1953. The contract to build the church was let on March 1, 1954, and work was begun the next day.

Today, the Day of Dedication, by the grace of God, the liberality and faith of its members and the very generous help of many friends, this Church, with its attractive design and greatly expanded facilities, stands upon the threshold of an era of far greater privilege and service than ever before. thanks be to God!
