

TARTAN BANNER CONSTRUCTION

St Simons Presbyterian Church

Usage:

Banners on poles are carried in procession for the Kirkin' o' the Tartan Service. Poles are placed in holders in the choir loft for the duration of the service. Banners are donated to the church by members. Either the donor or their designee carries the banner. Banners and poles are stored at the church.

Banner (25" x 42"):

Purchase light-weight (8oz) wool tartan fabric 29" wide by 47" long.

Make 1½" side hems folding under ½" extra so the piece is 25" wide.

Make a 2" bottom hem, folding under ½" extra.

Make a 2" rod-pocket hem, folding under ½" extra so the finished size is 42".

Attach a stitched/embroidered name tag to the back, bottom left side.

No fringe or clan badges.

Finished banner is 25" x 42"

Mounting: (provided by church)

Poles are 8' by 1 1/8" diameter stained Early American

Dowels 2'4" by ½" with ½" eye screws and Velcro bands

Gold cording (46" per pole)
